Giant's Causeway colt
out of Quiet Reward, by Seeking the Gold



Stunning bay has the spirit to match his good looks. You don't get much better than this pedigree—with champions throughout the top and bottom lines. Athletic, racy colt stands 15.2 already and he's got room to grow. The sky's the limit for this Canadian-bred fellow.

Some horses are destined for greatness, and this colt's sire, Giant's Causeway, is just such a horse. He is by Storm Cat, one of the most influential stallions in the history of the breed. His dam, Mariah's Storm, inspired the movie *Dreamer* with her courage and heart. She had suffered a fractured cannon bone at two, usually a career-ending injury, and recovered to win graded stakes at four. Giant's Causeway exhibited the same will. In his racing days, he was known as "The Iron Horse," and for good reason. Horse of the Year in Europe at three, he won five straight Group 1 races then came to America and finished second by a mere neck to Tiznow in the Breeders' Cup Classic-G1 in his first try on dirt. At stud, Giant's Causeway has climbed to the top of the stallion ranks. Champion First-Crop Sire in Europe and last year's top sire in North America, he currently ranks second on the 2010 General Sire list.

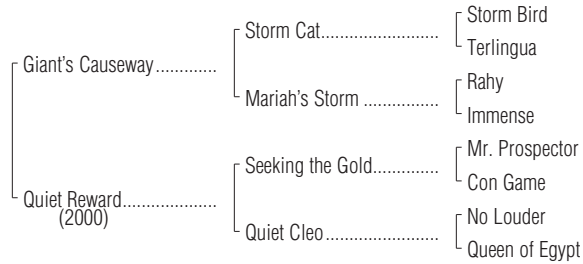
This colt's dam is the winning Seeking the Gold mare, Quiet Reward, a sister to Canadian Horse-of-the-Year, Grass Champion and \$2.3-million earner Quiet Resolve. His second and third dams are important stakes winners as well. Second dam Quiet Cielo won 14 races and \$500,000 plus. Third dam Queen of Egypt is a multiple stakes winner and multiple stakes producer. Her Champion daughter Eye of the Sphynx is only nine and has a 2009 Champion and Classic-winning first foal, Eye of the Leopard, and a promising 2010 sophomore stakes winner in Hotep.

Giant's Causeway is already the sire of Champion 2-year-olds, Classic-winning 3-year-olds, record-setting older horses, and exceptional colts and fillies on dirt, turf and all-weather. He is represented by 18 Group 1/Grade 1 winners. Of those, three were produced from Seeking the Gold mares like this colt. In addition, Giant's Causeway's best son to date, Shamardal, is out of a mare by Machiavellian, Champion son of Mr. Prospector, grandsire of Seeking the Gold. In fact, the Mr. Prospector line nicks beautifully with Giant's Causeway. Nearly half of his 84 stakes winners and 44 graded stakes winners are out of mares by Mr. Prospector or his sons and grandsons.
