



This colt's a chip off the old block in looks and attitude. Definitely all boy. Rough, but eager to get on with his lessons. A stout 15.2 with plenty of scope. Seems precocious, but then again his sire only got better with age when he raced.

This colt's sire, Corinthian, had an aura of success from the get-go. A son of leading sire Pulpit, he is out of a mare by Easy Goer from the remarkable family that produced international sires Nureyev and Sadler's Wells. Corinthian also exhibited a lot of talent, but he was known to be quite spirited around the barn. He broke his maiden in his second start in the fall of his juvenile season. He then won an allowance race at Gulfstream early in his 3-year-old year, but his antics caught up with him in the Fountain of Youth S.-G2. Although he was clearly the best in that important Derby prep, Corinthian was disqualified to third after an erratic stretch run. Away from the races for nearly a year, Corinthian emerged a bigger, stronger, more mature horse at four. He turned heads when he beat Belmont S.-G1 winner Jazil by 9 1/2 lengths in his seasonal debut, and then won the Gulfstream Park H.-G2 by a determined neck in his next start. He won the Metropolitan H.-G1 and culminated the year with an emphatic 6 1/2-length win in the inaugural running of the Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile. Corinthian has been extremely popular at stud, and this colt is from his first crop.

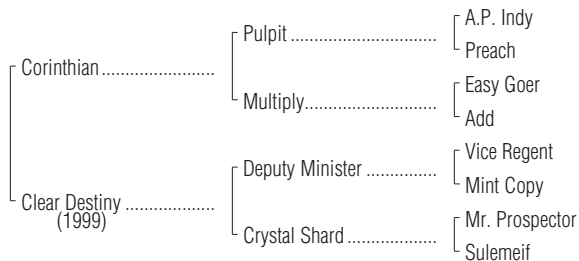
This colt hails from a family that exudes quality. He is out of Clear Destiny, a stakes winner by leading broodmare sire Deputy Minister, who finished first or second in 10 of her 15 starts. Clear Destiny is out of the Mr. Prospector mare Crystal Shard, who brought \$460,000 in the sales ring. Crystal Shard is a full sister to Bonnie Miss S.-G2 winner Withallprobability. The dam of graded stakes winner With Ability, Withallprobability is also the granddam of Personal Ensign-G1 winner and millionaire Summer Colony as well as 2010 stakes winner Cajun Conquest. Other distinguished horses from this family include Oak Leaf-G1 winner One of a Klein, and Ashland S-G1 winner and Kentucky Oaks-G1 placed Bare Minimum.

Rags to Riches, the brilliant filly who won the Belmont S.-G1 a few years ago, is the most famous of the runners produced from the A.P. Indy-Deputy Minister cross. Other noteworthy graded stakes winners bred on this cross include Boston Harbor, Casino Drive, Cocoa Beach, Friesan Fire, and Minister Eric.
